Dear Parent/Carers,

We are at the beginning of our last half term in school this year and have some great activities planned. We will continue to follow our risk assessment, in line with government guidance, and communicate any updates as they come to light. Please can we reinforce the importance of social distancing measures when entering the school site. We encourage masks to be worn at all times, socially distancing where possible and one parent to drop-off and pick-up. From next week, the caretaker will open the gates so our older children can come straight onto the yard and be ready to come into school from 8.45 – 9.00. The younger children can come onto their yard with whoever is dropping off but please do not use this time to gather with other parents and carers. With the risk of transmitting Covid 19 remaining high, it is important that we all do what we can to prevent the spread of

We would like to also remind parent/carers that if you would like your child to be collected from school by another adult, the school office must be informed on the day. This is to ensure that our safeguarding procedures are adhered to. Please also be aware that young people below the age of 16 are not allowed to collect younger children.

As a school we have always tried to build positive relationships with families of our children which helps to make your child's time here at Our Lady of the Rosary a happy and memorable one. We always treat our children and families with respect and would expect the same in return to our members of staff. We would always ask that if you have any concerns or questions raise please contact your child's class teacher via Class Dojo or contact the school office and not to raise concerns with members of staff on the school yard.

### **Holy Communion Information**

For those children who began their programme of preparation for First Holy Communion in 2019-20 we continue to prepare the children in school so they are able to make their First Holy Communion on Saturday 19<sup>th</sup> June 2021 at 10am in church (Due to COVID restrictions currently in place, spaces are unfortunately limited to immediate family only and there will not be the usual celebration back in school after Mass).

There will be a carousel of activities taking place throughout the day. We are hoping, if COVID restrictions allow, to invite parents to attend at set points throughout the day. Further information will follow with regard to this.

A separate sports day will be held for Nursery children. Further information will be issued to parents.

#### **Summer Holiday Activities**

## Week 1 (26th-30th July 2021)

Cost: £5 per day

Children sign up for any day(s) to experience a carousel of activities to include:

Cooking, arts and craft, board and team games, gardening, drama and parachute games.

## Forest school Monday 26th July and Tuesday 27th July

Cost: £5 per day

Children sign up for a one day experience to take part in creative activities such as outdoor arts and develop survival skills such as shelter building and cooking on a fire. The day will give pupils the opportunity to learn key skills and concepts in a practical and meaningful way as well as increasing self-confidence and their ability to work cooperatively.

Please sign up using ParentPay by **Wednesday 23rd June** if you wish your child to take part in any of the above activities. These activities will show as Summer Schools and Forest School on ParentPay and places are limited.

## Week 2 (2<sup>nd</sup> -6<sup>th</sup> August 2021)



Cost: £40 for the full week

This week is led by Grassroots qualified coaches/teachers who deliver PE training and sessions in school.
