Dear Parent/Carer, Youth Village – Monday 11th October – Wednesday 13th October 2021

Please find below arrangements for the residential visit to the Diocesan Youth Village:-

Children should come to school at the normal time on the morning of Monday 11th October and We will depart school at approximately 1:30pm and will leave the Youth Village at 2 pm on Wednesday 13th October 2021 to return to school for 3:15pm home time.

The children should wear comfortable clothing and sensible footwear as some activities may be outside. They must bring a waterproof coat. They will need an overnight bag with toiletries, towel etc. pyjamas and a change of clothing for the next two days (uniform not necessary).

All rooms have en-suite facilities and all rooms are provided with clean sheets, pillow cases and duvet covers.

School staff will also be accommodated in a separate room in each corridor:-Teaching Staff: Mrs Bowdler Mrs Freer Miss Riddle Mrs Myhill

The Diocesan Youth Village offers a variety of different resources for recreational activities such as board games, cards, selection of DVDs and sports equipment such as football, cricket etc.

The children will be allowed up to ± 2 to spend at the tuck shop. They can also take a bottle of water with them.

Children will not be allowed any electrical or battery operated items with them i.e. hairdryers, phones, iPod etc.

All meals will be provided whilst the children are at the Youth Village. Children on school dinners should pay for three days dinner money that week as the children will have lunch on Monday in school and Wednesday at the Youth Village before they set off.
