Our class attendance is 93%

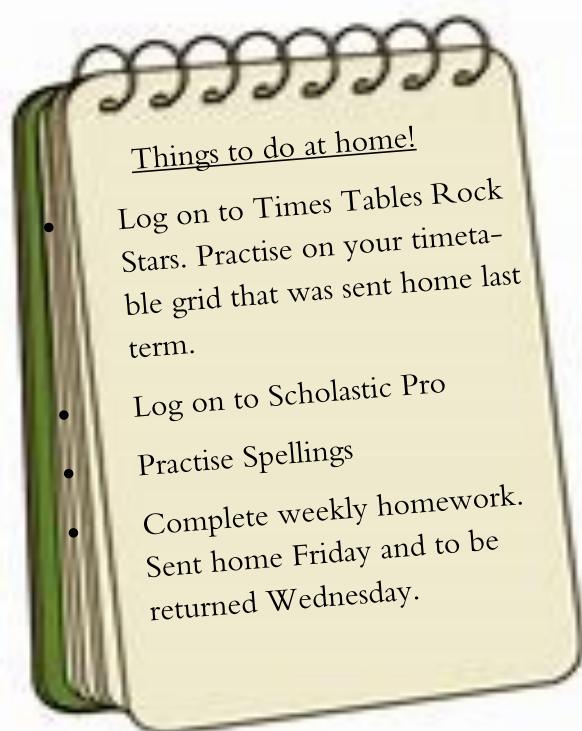

Reading a new class text—the name of which will be revealed when we return to school after half term.

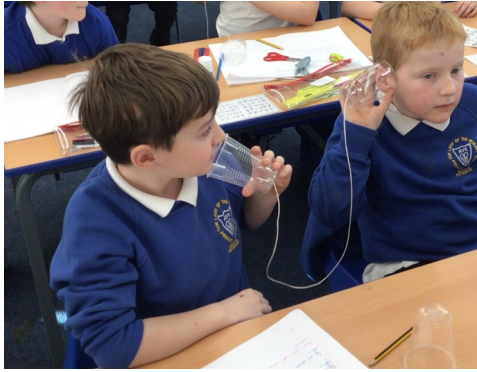
This term your child has been ...
