Good attendance is key to your child being able to fulfil their potential and make good progress in school. One of the most important ways a parent can support the education of their child and ensure the child's social, emotional and academic development is to ensure they attend every day and on time.





As you know, this can only be achieved if your child is attending school and has a good level of attendance. 95% attendance is regarded as the minimum acceptable level of attendance.

Currently, our school attendance is only at 92% which is a concern to us and most certainly to the DFE. After half term, we endeavour to report to you more regularly if your child has weak attendance as we need to understand why your child attendance is below the national expectation and how this can be improved. As per this year, no holidays will be authorised and any unauthorised attendance will be referred to the Local Authority who may issue a fine to parents who have parental responsibility for the child. We appreciate that there are genuine reasons for absence and we have had genuine conversations with parents in regards to this but we must also address any attendance that falls below expectations. Mrs Myhill, Miss Lawrence and the school council are looking at more rewards and incentives for good attendance individually and as a class. We plan to report the best attended class to you each week.

#### **Contact Details**

If any of your details have changed recently can we please ask that you contact the school office. This could be a change of address, or a change of phone number or perhaps a change in emergency contact details. We will then update our school records accordingly. We need a minimum of two contacts for safeguarding purposes to ensure we can make contact in an emergency. 
