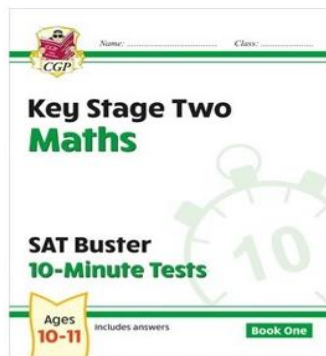
It's full steam ahead in regards to Year 6 SATs!
