Attendance continues to be a whole school target for every child across school. Thank you for supporting us in ensuring your child attends school.

Please continue to support us in ensuring your child attends school and arrives on time. We do understand that children are sometimes ill, if this is the case then please ensure that you phone the office to inform them of any reason that your child is off school. When a child is absent, the office will make phone calls to all families, and if we do not get a response then we follow this up which is often a home visit.

We have had a lot of requests recently for holidays. Unfortunately, all holidays will be unauthorised as we want the children to reach their full academic ability and not miss any school. Following Durham County Council advice, we are also now unable to authorise sporting events that have not been arranged via school.
